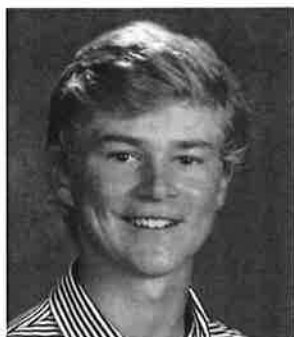

During the 2016 season Jack averaged 36.3 strokes for 9 hole matches and 72.25 for 18 hole events. He finished in the top 10 of every tournament he played in, winning 3 of them. He broke the Plymouth High School scoring record twice during the course of the season by firing rounds of 66 and 64. His outstanding achievement continues a run of great Plymouth players to earn Super Team Honors; Kelsey Murphey in 2012, Kyle Rhodes in 2013, and Katie Chipman in 2015. Jack is one for the hardest workers to wear the black and silver, being the first to practice every day and the last to leave the range at the end of the day. 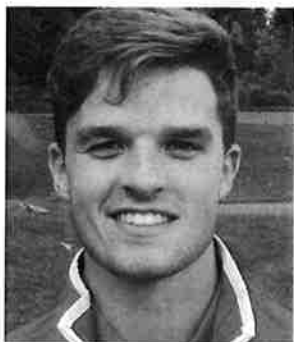


11 James Piot

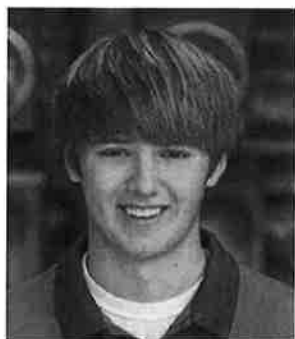


11 Zach Rosendale

11 Ben Smith Detroit Catholic Central Michael Anderson

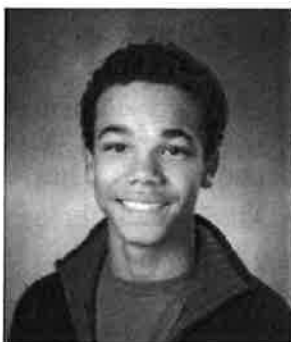

She has been All-State all 4 years including Super Team Member last two years. Stephanie's accomplishments in the classroom mirror her success on the course, where she earned Academic All-League and achieved Academic All- State in her senior year. Nichole completed her remarkable High School golf career in grand style. She won her third straight MHSAA Division IV State Championship at Forest Akers West Golf Course. She shot a two-day total of 150 (72 – 78), to win by 4 shots. Nichole was also the 2014 and 2015 State Champion. As a freshman, she finished in 3rd place at Battle Creek. She is one of only three (3) female golfers in the Lower Peninsula to win at least 3 MHSAA medalist awards and one of eight (8) when you include the Upper Peninsula. En-route to winning three (3) State championships, Nichole was the regional champion each of her four (4) High School



seasons. She was first team Division IV All-State in 2013 and 2014 and named to the Super Team in 2015 and 2016. Nichole averaged 74 per 18 hole round this season. She holds Glen Lake School Records for career wins (29), lowest 18-hole score (69), lowest 9-hole score (33) and had a hole-in-one in competition. In addition to her MHSAA schedule, Nichole did not shy away from competition in 2016. She competed in Michigan Women's Open, the GAM Jr. Invitational, the GAM Women's Amateur (semifinalist), the Women's Western National Jr. Championships in Wisconsin and the Traverse City Junior Golf Association tournament schedule. Nichole is honorable mention Individual Academic All-State this year and was part of Glen Lake's Team Academic All-State her freshmen, sophomore and junior years. She is a member of the National Honor Society and the Varsity Bowling Team. Coach Paul Christiansen said, "The Glen Lake community is so proud of Nichole's golfing achievements. She has represented herself, her family and school with class. She set high goals and has worked extremely hard to achieve those. There was a lot of pressure and expectations for Nichole to win her third championship. One of the hardest things in sport is to repeat as champion, let alone 3-peat and Nichole closed the deal. We are so happy for Nichole and her family." Nichole has signed a National Letter of Intent to play college golf for the Bowling Green State University Falcons in 2017.

Anika Dy, only a sophomore, dominated her second year on varsity without a doubt. Although her first year on Traverse City West's team was impressive, she still wasn't satisfied and came back more driven after individually placing runner-up by one stroke at the finals last year. Anika is humbled to say she has led her team to the 2015 Division 1 State Finals Title, won Regionals for the past two years, made the All-State Team Division I in 2015, made the Big North Conference First Team the past two years, and competed in the Drive Chip and Putt National Finals at Augusta National for the past two years, placing third overall for Girls 14-15 this past April 2015. The pressure to have another phenomenal season this past fall wasn't a factor for Anika. An impressive under-par scoring average of 70.7 has brought her to total of 11-under par for the season. Anika was the medalist in 10 out of the 13 tournaments she played in and was runner-up in the other 3 events. Right at the start of the season, she broke the course record at Grayling CC with a 5-under par, 65. She later went on to break another course record with a 5-under 67 at Petoskey-Bay View CC. Anika's dedication to work hard and play her best helped her tie yet another record at Lincoln Hills GC with a 6-under 66. Not only were low, but her worst score this entire season was just a 4-over 76. The consistency she has showcased in her scores transfers to her academics as

well. She has learned how to balance the needs of golf and school by maintaining her 4.0 GPA, while still performing at the high level she does in golf. She helps keep her game tournament ready for the fall by competing in summer tournaments. Highlights include 3 top 10 AJGA finishes, 6th place at the Dustin Johnson World Junior Golf Championship at TPC Myrtle Beach, and medalist at the MI PGA Junior Championship (15 and under division). Anika is eagerly looking forward to what the next two years will bring!

Anna had another outstanding season, leading Spring Lake to its third state title in a row. She was a medalist at the Kenowa Hills Invitational with a 69 and the Sparta Invitational with a 34. During OK Blue Conference play Anna had an average of 37.75 was medalist in 8 jamborees. During the postseason she was medalist in the Division 3 Regional with an 80. At the Division 3 State Finals in Battle Creek, Anna shot a 78/75 for a two day total of 153. That score tied her for first but she fell in a playoff. She finished her career as All-State both as a freshman and a sophomore, and Super Team as a Junior and Senior. As a freshman she finished 4th at the MHSAA State Finals, she was runner-up as a sophomore and senior, and she was MHSAA State Champion her junior season. In addition, she led the Spring Lake Lakers to 3 consecutive team state titles. Not only did she have an outstanding senior season, she also had an amazing summer on the links. She won the Women's GAM Championship followed by making the Sweet Sixteen in the Michigan's Women's Amateur. Anna plans to continue her education and golf career at the University of Indianapolis.

Kerri has been a 4 year Varsity Captain and Most Valuable Player on the Flushing High School Golf team. Her 18 hole scoring average was 73.6. Her low round of 70 earned her the Medalist award at the Flint Metro League Conference Post Season Tournament. She was the medalist in 11 of the 12 events this season and scored par or under par in 7 of those events. Kerrigan has placed in the 10 top in three State Finals events and placed 3rd in Division II this season at The Meadows with a two day score of 150. As a freshman, Kerrigan earned 1st team All-League in the Saginaw Valley League. She earned 1st team All-League in the Flint Metro League her sophomore and junior years. Kerrigan was also 1st team All-State as a sophomore and junior. Not only is Kerri an excellent athlete, she is also an exceptional student. She has maintained a GPA she can be very proud of throughout her high school career. Kerrigan is a truly a leader on and off the course.

Her first two tournaments of the year she posted scores of -1, finished medalist (twice) and runner-up (four times) in seven total events played. She co-led after the first day of the state finals, shooting an even par 71 and finished second overall after day 2.
