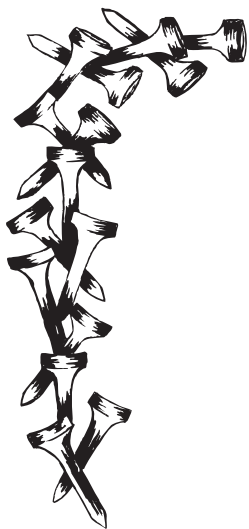

Austin had a great 2017 campaign this year playing in nine golf tournaments (including regionals and states) that had medalist honors, Austin claimed eight of those honors. Including the Division IV State Championship at Michigan State Forest Akers, East course. Austin really focused on his short game in the off-season and it showed with his scores throughout the season, which hovered right at around, +2 to -2 consistently, during the season. "He grinds every time he steps on a course and as a coach that is what I'm proud of him for", stated Coach Ramos. Pierce had a quality sophomore season. He won 9 of his 18 tournaments. He was top 5 in 13 events and top 10 in all 18. He was 1st at the Cardinal Invite, the Nightmare Invite, TC 2-day on Wolverine, all 5 of his conference tournaments and his Regional at Railside GC and 3rd overall at the Southern Swing 2 Day Invite. He finished the season with a 74.17 average and T-5th at the Division 3 state finals that helped the Cardinals finish 2nd in the Division 3 state finals at Katke GC. Pierce sets the example for practice. His countless hours spent refining his short game have helped him take his game to the next level. He is a teammate that inspires, listens, enjoys playing the game and plays it with honor. He supports his school and community by being involved in the Mecosta County Youth Advisory Council, Project Outreach, Vice President of Student Council, BRHS Climate Crew, coaching for the Tip Off Youth Basketball program and is a representative of the Fellowship of Christian Athletes.



12 Sean Niles Novi Catholic Central James Dewing

Sean Niles is an amazing high school golf story of persistence. Although Sean had multiple teammates of many years of accomplishments, Sean worked his way up from the Detroit Catholic Central Junior Varsity team to winning Detroit Catholic Centrals 1st Individual Division 1 State Title. Once in the shadow of other players at DCC golfers, Sean averaged 71.64 his senior year. Without the progression of Sean Niles from Freshman year to Senior year, the Shamrocks would not have won 3 straight Division 1 State Championships. Sean continues to progress and contribute as a NCAA Division 1 golfer at Oakland University.



12 James Piot Novi Catholic Central James Dewing

Since his Freshman year, James Piot has been one of the strongest players in Michigan High School golf. As a four year MIGCA Super Team member, there have been few players who have accumulated the accomplishments of James. Leading the team in scoring average all 4 years, James was also the Captain of the first team since 1948 to 3-Peat as Division 1 State Champions. A senior year scoring average of 71.21 included 5 victories, and 3 rounds under 70, including a school record 64 at Katke-Cousins Ferris State. One of the most impressive statistics is James Piot's individual win/loss record per round. In total, during the 2017 season, high school golfers had an opportunity to beat James Piot a total of 1,230 times. The field only beat James 30 times, and 8 of those individuals were DCC golfers. An incredible and historic display of consistency. Grit is defined as strength in character. There will never be a player as gritty and dedicated to winning as James Piot at Detroit Catholic Central. James has continued his career at Michigan State University and has already earned a spot in the starting line-up.



12 Tyler Rayman Otsego Matt Rayman

Tyler was all- wolverine conference 1st team 4 years, 3 time Kalamazoo gazette golfer of the year, 4 time all county 1st team, 3 year captain, Allstate honorable mention freshman, sophomore years, 1st team junior year, super team senior year, he played in the state finals all 4 years finishing 4th his sophomore year, 10th his junior year, and 7th his senior year, never had a round in the 80's for 8 rounds.



12 Zach Rosendale St. Johns Paul Sternburgh

Zach Rosendale has been a varsity golfer for St. Johns High School for four years. During that time he was all state twice, Dream Team last year, and now Mr. Golf after a successful senior season. Zach finished top 3 in all 17 tournaments including six first place finishes and capping off his high school career capturing Division 2 state medalist this past spring. His 18 hole average was 70.4 which included 8 subpar round scores and his overall average was 35.5. Zach was team captain 3 of his four seasons and displayed outstanding leadership skills while leading his team to back to back division 2 state championships. It has been an honor to have coached Zach during his four years at St. Johns High School.



11 Colin Sikkenga Kalamazoo Christian Brian Seifert

Colin Sikkenga had a great junior year in boys golf and obviously being named to the 2017 Super Team is a great honor and accomplishment. Colin's season unfolded something like this. 1st Team all Southwest Athletic Conference & Player of the Year. 3rd consecutive year with both accomplishments. Colin averaged 37 for nine hole play in the SAC, medalist in 4 of the 7 matches, with his lowest round being a 34. Colin placed 3rd in the SAC Conference tournament, shooting 75. Colin averaged 74 for the season for 18 holes, with his best golf in the last part of the year. Colin was the regional medalist shooting a 74, carding an eagle 2 on a par 4, just for fun. And in the State Tournament, Colin shot 73 on day 1 and 71 on day 2, even par for the tournament. Colin placed 3rd in the State tournament and was named to the all tournament team for a third year in a row. Colin's addition to the 2017 Super Team adds to his all state selection for the third year in a row as well. Colin's season included placing third in the Rockford Invite (MHSAA Division 1), shooting a 77. That was Colin's highest round for the year but one of the best rounds he played. The course was set to 6900 yards and the wind blew straight from the north all day at 20mph. It was cold and the course was dry and fast and narrow. Colin's ability to scramble was put to the test, as was everybody's, and the kid never wavered. Medalist was 74. Colin is, as the late ESPN Anchor Stuart Scott used to say, 'as cool as the other side of the pillow.' Nothing shakes Colin. Colin is as patient a golfer I've ever seen. Colin has the unique ability to play the game of golf with such a mental vigor that translates to on course performance and his consistent control of his game this season made him one tough opponent to face.





12 Ben Smith Novi Catholic Central James Dewing

A three time MIGCA Super Team recipient and a three time Division 1 State Champion at Detroit Catholic Central, Ben Smith had a historic junior golf career. Ben averaged 72.13 during the high school season being medalist during 5 different rounds. In cold rainy weather at Ferris State, Ben shot an amazing round 66. His teammates admitted it was one of the most impressive rounds of golf they have witnessed, especially given the conditions. Ben dominated the high school season with his amazing ability to flight the golf ball. The harder and longer the golf course, the greater chance it would be Ben Smith's name at the top of the leaderboard. Ben leaves Detroit Catholic Central as one of the best players in program history and is now a freshman in a top 10 collegiate program, Georgia Tech.

9 Anci Dy Traverse City West Karl Gagnon

Following the footsteps of the best junior golfer in the state is no doubt a daunting task, but freshman Anci Dy has embraced the challenge and has proven that she is ready to step out of her sister's shadow and embark on her own journey. Anci's goal is to not be as good as Anika, she wants to be better. As a freshman, she came out strong and determined. She won her first two high school golf tournaments, the Lober Invitational and the Big Rapids Invite where she gave Anika her only runner-up finish of the year. Anci has an amazing scoring average of 75.13 and was in the top three in all of her high school golf tournaments this year except for the State finals where she tied for sixth and helped her Traverse City West Team to a state title. Anci does not only excel in golf but in the classroom as well. She has been a straight A student since she started. She is also very active in her school community by taking on student leadership in Class Council, Choir Council, and Student Council. As a freshman, to be included in the 2017 Super Team is such a great honor. Her dedication and hard work has certainly paid off. She really enjoyed high school golf and is excited for what the next three years will bring.



11 Anika Dy Traverse City West Karl Gagnon

Anika Dy, a junior, has led Traverse City West to its second state championship since she joined the team three seasons ago in 2015. Not only did her team win this Fall, she also claimed the individual Division 1 state title for the second time with a 3-under par two day total at The Meadows at Grand Valley State University. Her scoring average this season is a phenomenal 69.6, a one stroke improvement from last year. Out of the ten rounds she played in (including the two-day state final rounds), six of them were in the sixties and the other four were even par. Although the lowest round she carded, a 7-under 65, was quite impressive, the fact that her highest score the whole season was a 72 (even par) is even more. It was not all smooth sailing, however, for the eleventh grader. In her first tournament of the season, she had to settle for runner-up to her little sister, freshman Anci Dy, who beat her by one stroke. Aside from that one tournament, Anika won all her events that followed for a total of eight medalist honors. Other highlights of the season include a 3-peat Big North Conference and Regional medalist finishes, and being part of the Super Team for a second year. Anika's dedication and drive to be the best on the course translates to the classroom too, as she shows by maintaining an excellent GPA. Even with all her accomplishments, Anika is most known for being a supportive team player with class and humility. She plans to take these qualities with her to the University of Michigan where she's verbally committed to play.



10 Savannah Haque Rochester Jeff Haney

Savannah Haque is a sophomore and two-year varsity player for Rochester High School. She followed up a very good freshmen season last year by having one of the best seasons in school history this year. Savannah's season scoring average of 74.5 was one of the best in the state and she finished the season by taking 3rd in the Twin Lakes Regional and finishing runner-up in the Division 1 State Finals at The Meadows, shooting a two-day total of 149. She was named to the OAA Red All-League team and Oakland County Dream Team for the second time and didn't finish outside of the top 4 in any tournament she played this year. She won both the Lapeer Tune-Up and Patriot Cup and had four other 2nd place finishes. She is an outstanding student with an excellent GPA and sets a great example of hard work and dedication for her teammates with the time and focus she puts into her golf game.



9 Shannon Kennedy Marian Leon O. Braisted III

Shannon has the potential to be one the best player coming out of the great state of Michigan. As a Freshman, she won her 3rd & 4th tournaments (American Control & Top 50jr tour – Pre-Catholic League) of playing high School golf shooting two 74s. Shannon also placed 2nd at both the Lakeview Spartans Invite and MHSAA Regionals. She saved her best performance for the MHSAA State Finals! She completed her season with a final sup par round of golf shooting a 70 to win the Division II States. Her class, composure and being very coachable on the golf course is incredible! We (Marian, Coaches & Teammates) look forward to seeing many greater things from Shannon Kennedy.



12 Catherine Loftus Saline Debbie Williams-Hoak

Catherine is one of the All Time Best Saline golfers. During her career she set or tied 6 Hornet all-time records including 9-hole scoring average of 37.5, low 18-hole round of 67, 12- 1st place finishes in one year, 9 All Tournament Team Selections in one year and 4 All State All Academic Team Selections. She was an All State Honorable Mention selection in 2015 and All State Selection in 2016. She has the 2nd all-time low scoring average of 75.92 which she set this season. Also, during this season Catherine was the Conference Tournament Champion, made the SEC All- Conference Team with the most points, won Regionals, and made the All State Tournament Team finishing 3rd which helped the team finish 3rd at the State Finals. She has helped her team set 9 All Time Hornet records including the low 18-hole team score of 298 where Catherine shot 67 and the low 9-hole team score with 149. During her 4-yr. career the team has won 19 invitationals and had a 40-1 Conference record. It has been such a privilege to have Catherine on our team the last 4 years. Young ladies with such character, integrity, a great work ethic, academic success and skill like Catherine are a coach's dream. Securing a spot on the varsity squad Serena started her high school career, by finishing in 7th place individually at the Division 4 state finals shooting an 83/86. From there she took off and never looked back. As a sophomore she finished 4th in the state carding an 82/80, in her junior season she again took the 4th spot with 79/79 and this season to end her career in Division 3 she was the state runner-up shooting a 78/74. Serena was the catalyst that took the Mustang team from being good to being Champions. Her work ethic is beyond any that I have seen at her age. 11 Mikaela Schulz Bloomfield Hills Brendan Harrington



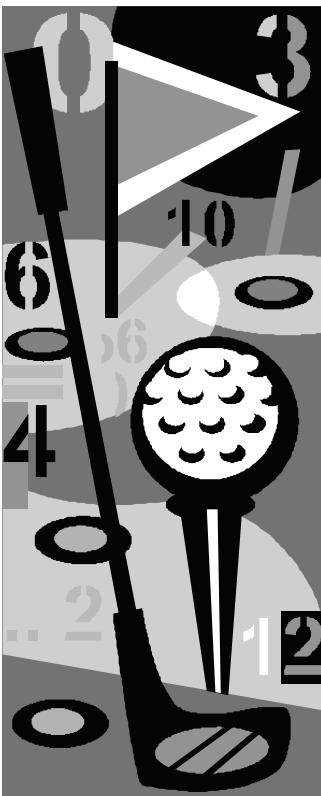
